**Old Business:**

- A. *2009 Annual Celebration – Update*

Trustee Stone stated that everything is going good. He stated that Gobin's will print the flyers. He also asked Lytle about the fire department events. Lytle stated that she will get with Dell and Eveatt. Clodfelter stated that TTO (KBLJ) has been schedule for May 29th and June 5th. Stone stated that he and Clodfelter will go on the 29th and Wallace will go on June 5th with Clodfelter. Clodfelter stated that she has made a special trip to Old Colorado City and passed out flyers for the booth, parade and the agenda. She stated that she also attended Canon City's event. Stone talked about having a burn out contest but will talk with Mr. Malouff about it. Clodfelter stated she talked with Village Inn and they will donate ten (10) pies to us. Stone stated that we will have BINGO at the Swink Community Center. Clodfelter stated that the beer garden is set and ready to go. Stone stated that we still need booths and parade entries. Clodfelter stated that she has been on the phone this last week getting people for booths and will start calling people next week for the parade.

A. ***Quick Books Class – Colorado Springs***

**Public Hearing:**

A. ***Hogg Stopp Saloon – Debra Basye***

Mr. Malouff opened the public hearing up for any comments. Mr. Malouff went over the renewal application and advised Mrs. Basye about being in control of the bar at all times and about customers leaving the bar and getting a DUI. He also advised council that they can pass the renewal, continue the hearing, decline the renewal or go into executive session. Mr. Malouff stated that all fees have been paid to the State and to the Town, legal notices have been properly posted and the application is complete. He asked Mrs. Basye to explain the modification to council. Mrs. Basye stated that she will be installing a fence inside the concrete sidewalk and the fence will run across the end of the metal business to her home. The fence will be wood and will have a gate for emergence exist but will be kept locked. Mr. Malouff asked if she has talked with Chief Eveatt from the La Junta Fire Department. She stated that she has and he will be up to approve the modification per fire code laws. She stated that she

would get any permit needed from the Town. Mr. Malouff asked if anyone was her to speak for the modification or the renewal. There were no comments. Council had no questions or comments. Mr. Malouff closed the public hearing.
